Over the past several weeks we have had the opportunity to meet with student groups, faculty groups, retirees, alumni, and concerned community members.

And over these past several weeks, we have seen two increasingly-divergent views of the "McGill Community" be put forth. On one hand, we have a McGill of centralized decision-making, displacing burdens onto those least able to bear them; a McGill that engages in a rhetoric of free speech while strong-arming and attempting to demonize organizations and individuals who disagree; a McGill that looks more and more like a business and less like a university.

On the other hand, there is a vision of a McGill community centered around learning: in the lab, in the classroom, and beyond; a McGill that is accountable to those it represents; a McGill that respects its workers, respects its students, and respects everyone who contributes to make this university what it is. This is the real McGill community, and it's one in which QPIRG and CKUT are not only valuable parts, but necessary to stand up and sustain this vision of the university.
